Eligible media:

All pieces must be original. Commercial molds, patterns, kits, copies, etc. will not be accepted. Works in ceramic, drawing, fiber, glass, jewelry, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, wood, metal, paper or mixed media are eligible for submission. Only prints that are hand pulled, properly signed and numbered are permitted to be displayed on and in the booth.

Exhibit space:

Each participant will be allotted an area of approximately 10' x 10' on grass. Participants should erect tents that will withstand winds and crowds but may not use any staking device. Tents must be supported or anchored by cement blocks, sand bags, or other appropriate weights. No electricity is available at the exhibit spaces and generators are prohibited.

Set up:

Set up time will be Saturday, September 11, 2010 from 7 am- 9 am. Artists' displays must remain set up throughout the entire show. Those found leaving before the designated tear down will not be allowed to attend the following year.

Entry deadline:

This completed application, along with at least three (but not more than six) representative digital images of the artist's work and one photo of the artist's booth, must be postmarked by August 23, 2010. No late applications will be accepted. Digital images on a CD or via email are required – no slides or photographs will be accepted. If more than six images are submitted, the jury will review only the first six. All acceptances or rejections will be emailed by August 30, 2010. Space-fee checks will not be deposited until after an artist's work is accepted. Space-fee checks will be returned if the work is rejected. CDs will not be returned.

Other considerations:

Images submitted with applications must represent current work which is intended to be sold in the artist's booth. Only artists accepted by the Parkside Fine Arts Festival jury will be allowed to participate. If an artist submits images in more than one category, the jury will evaluate the works in each category individually. It is possible that the jury will accept work in one category but not in another. Spaces will be numbered and exhibitors must stay within the space allotted. Subletting, selling, or giving space to anyone will not be permitted. Only artists displaying their own original work may participate. Artists must be present with their work for the entire day of the fair. No booth or display may be dismantled before 5:00 p.m. without the committee's permission. No pets, alcoholic beverages or drugs on the premises. Check in must be complete before setting up displays.

Space Fees ONE Show: \$25/ Member • \$75/ Non-Members

Space Fees BOTH Show (Only requires one application): \$40/ Member • \$140/ Non-Members

Parkside Arts Festival is a rain-or-shine event; plan accordingly. Only extreme weather conditions clearly hazardous to artists and their artwork, patrons, and staff will close this event down. Fees are non-refundable in any case.

Proceeds from the fair support the Parkside Arts Council. The mission of the Parkside Arts Council is to encourage cultural enrichment in Antrim County by promoting awareness, education and appreciation of the arts, and supporting those who do creative work.
