This course shows you how to use Adobe Photoshop 7.0 to perform many different image processing techniques. In this course, you will learn how to use several tools for selecting parts of images, and will move, duplicate and resize images. You will learn to use layers, layer effects, filters, and color modification. Also, you will learn how to create images of different formats for different applications including digital slide submission, online uploading, and fine art printing.

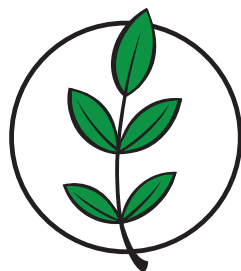
Prerequisites:
